

SPRINGER NATURE TÜBİTAK READ&PUBLISH AGREEMENT (NEW)

About the Agreement

Within the scope of the EKUAL Project carried out by TÜBİTAK ULAKBİM, access is provided to more than 2,300 electronic journals of Springer Nature. The current 2022-2024 Springer Nature agreement, which is an access (Read) agreement, has been transformed into the "Read & Publish" model as of January 1, 2024, covering the period 2024-2026.

The Scope of "publish" Agreement

- Springer Nature Hybrid Journals of Q1 and Q2 Group in Web of Science (SCI, SSCI, AHCI)
- Types of articles covered by the agreement: Original Paper, Review Paper, Continuing Education

What authors need to know

- \checkmark You must be the corresponding author of the article.
- \checkmark You must be affiliated with a participating Turkish institution.
- ✓ You must identify yourself during the author identification process (you will be asked to do this once your article has been accepted for publication). The institution selected during this process should be your primary affiliation, as this is the institution that TÜBİTAK will refer to in order to verify your eligibility.
- \checkmark You must explicitly state your primary affiliation in the published manuscript, which is the Turkish institution at which the bulk of the research for the article was conducted.

APC

Article Proccessing Charge (APC)

APC is a fee paid to the publisher to make an article immediately and freely available online.

Corresponding Author

The corresponding author is the one individual who takes primary responsibility for communication with the journal during the manuscript submission, peer review, and publication process.**
